



ANNUAL PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

Dear Parents / Guardians:

The District has adopted a Least-Toxic Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Policy (Administrative Regulation 3514.2). The policy states that pests will be controlled to protect the health and safety of the students and staff, to maintain a productive learning environment and to maintain the integrity of the school buildings and grounds. It is the policy of the district to focus and develop long-term pest prevention methods and give “non-chemical” methods first consideration when selecting appropriate control measures.

The Healthy Act of 2000 requires all California school districts to provide parents or guardians of students with annual written notification of expected pesticide use on school sites. This school year, there is no planned use of any pesticide at any Ross Valley School District properties. In the event there is an emergency need to use a pesticide, parents and guardians requesting prior notification will be notified at least 72 hours before pesticides are applied.
